Council consists of the <u>national office bearers (NOB), the immediate past president, the immediate past secretary general, maximum 25 (twenty five) member councilors elected by general members and one branch councilor from each branch (elected or selected by branch executive committee). A council member must be at least an associate member of the society.</u>

Secretary General of the society will provide secretarial support for the advisory committee.</u></p>
