Bangladesh Computer Society (BCS) is going to organize a training course on "Information Security Management Systems ISO 27001:2013: Auditor/ Lead Auditor" to be held on 19-20 August 2016. Related information of the course is stated below:

1. About ISMS Auditor / Lead Auditor Training Course:

This training course is designed for those who wish to become Information Security Management System (ISMS) auditor and is based on ISO 27001:2013. Successful qualification in Auditor / Lead Auditor training course is a pre-requisite for IRCA (International Register of Certificated Auditors) empanelment of ISMS Auditors.

2. Course Objectives:

To gain knowledge & skill for conducting ISMS audits.

Knowledge:

- Understand the purpose of an information security management system (ISMS) and the processes involved in establishing, implementing, operating, monitoring, reviewing and improving ISMS as defined in ISO/IEC 27001:2013.
- Understand the purpose, content and interrelationship of ISO/IEC 27001:2013, ISO 19011, ISO TR 18044, other ISO 27000 family of standards, and the legislative framework relevant to ISMS.
- Understand the role of an auditor to plan, conduct, report and follow up ISMS audit in accordance with ISO 19011.

Skill:

- Interpret the requirements of ISO 27001: 2005 and ISO 27006 in the context of ISMS audit.
- Undertake the role of an auditor to plan, conduct, report and follow up an audit in accordance with ISO 19011.

3. Course Contents:

The program is highly skill oriented and is based on Accelerated Learning Techniques recommended by IRCA. Following main topics suitably supported with a number of Exercises (Individual as well as Team Exercises) will be covered in the course:

4. Who Should Attend:

This training course is meant for those who wish to become ISMS Auditor. These may be IT Professionals, IT Managers, IT Engineers, IT Consultants, Quality/Safety Managers, System Administrators, Information Security Officers (ISO), System Managers, Existing Security Auditors, Information System Auditors, Owner Managers, Information security practitioners, Information Security Officers / Managers, ISMS Designers, ISMS Consultants, etc.

5. Selection Criteria:

Selection will be based on First Come First Serve (FCFS) basis but priority will be given to Bank Officials those who are working in Audit/ Inspection and officials from ICT Division.

6. Pre-requisites:

It is expected that participants have completed University level of education. Participants should be working professionals and are also expected to have an understanding of the principles supporting ISMS and of the ISO 27001: 2013 standard. The course focuses on teaching & developing ISMS audit skills and should not be looked as basis for learning ISMS.

7. Course Duration and Timings:

The course duration is Two Days (19-20 August 2016). The timing is 09:00 am to 06:00 pm daily.

8. Course Material

The delegates will receive standards (IS/ISO 27001 & IS/ISO 19011) for use during the course and course material consisting of Participants material, Exercise manual and Stationery.

9. Course Fee:

Course fee is BDT 11,500.00 (Eleven Thousand Five Hundred) only including VAT and Tax. 20% Discount for active BCS Members. The fees can be remitted through Payorder /in Cash only to Bangladesh Computer Society (BCS), House No.: 519 (4th Floor), Road No.: 1, Dhanmondi R/A, Dhaka-1205, Bangladesh.
